PROCEDURES

In the first year, coaches will connect with teams every other month. As the team begins, there may be need for monthly sessions and will be mutually agreed upon. In the second and third year of Life of Faith Initiative, the coach will meet with teams monthly. The Coach will listen, ask powerful questions, and remind you of the Life of Faith purpose, your goals and be truth teller when the team regresses.
